

Franciscan Hospital for Children Kiosk Update

As a result of Mr. Douglas Chamberlain and Appleton Partners, Inc.'s generous donation, Franciscan Hospital for Children will soon be home to a freestanding MindKare Kiosk, where users can “get a check-up from the neck up” and take a variety of mental health assessments. Franciscan Children’s has agreed to feature the kiosk for the entirety of the 99 Faces Exhibit opening at the Museum of Science on Memorial Day weekend.

Kiosk Updates and Deliverables

- Screening for Mental Health (SMH) worked with Franciscan Children's to customize branding for the kiosk.
- The kiosk screening is loaded and ready on the kiosk and all software has been set-up
- Staff members from Franciscan Children's were trained on the screening admin portal and Downloadable Resource Center
- Wallet card and poster designs are currently being printed in time for Franciscan Children's to pass out cards at NAMI walks event on May 13th
- The kiosk will be delivered to SMH within the next few days
- Franciscan Staff will come for a visit to see the kiosk before it goes to the Museum of Science
- SMH will manage the transportation to MOS and get the kiosk set up.

Moving Forward

The kiosk will soon reside at the Museum of Science as a part of the 99 Faces exhibit, which will extend from Memorial Day weekend to the fall. Mr. Douglas Chamberlain, Appleton Partners, and Franciscan Children's will all be acknowledged at SMH's Museum of Science event on September 12th. Once the exhibit concludes, there will be a formal launch for the kiosk at Franciscan Hospital for Children.
