Ngoc-Tran Vu was born in Saigon, Vietnam, and raised in Dorchester and South Boston. After commencing from The Steppingstone Academy in 2000, Tran attended The Winsor School and was awarded the Gates Millennium Scholarship in her senior year of high school. Tran went on to receive a bachelor's degree in ethnic studies and visual arts at Brown University and later earned a master's degree in arts and politics at New York University's Tisch School of the Arts.

Tran is a multimedia and transnational artist whose work draws from her experience as a community organizer and educator. Tran is currently the lead artist of a public art mural project in Fields Corner, Dorchester, which will be a tribute to the Vietnamese American narrative and local residents. Tran also serves as the Program Director for AIR, Association of Independents in Radio.
